Call to Order/Roll Call:

Discussion:

Norm:

- PennDOT Bid Packet has been submitted by Cory Shaffer. Roads to be paved include Crescent to Linwood, Elizabeth, Center to Elizabeth and part of Stuart Alley.
- The cost to rent a track hoe would be over \$1000 including delivery and pickup of machine. Norm has spoken with private parties, one of which is willing to do the work for \$600 – all inclusive.
- Will have a meeting with Stephenson's Equipment regarding grants that are available to purchase a new leaf machine.
- Street sweeping quotes will be available for the May meeting. Parking will need to be enforced by police this year.

Brad:

- ECWSA has begun landscaping work in yards that have been disrupted by the new line work.
- The advertisement for a part-time worker should be put out as soon as possible.

- Zoning webinar that Diana attended will be reimbursed if the recording is sent to the office for others to watch.
- Community Board lighting has been repaired.
- Beth will display a color-coded map of streets that have been paved each year, outside the office window.
- Has contacted Pittsburgh Pride Softball regarding the community ballfields. They plan on replacing the T-Ball field. The borough might own the fields, but a title search will need to be done on the property.
- Furnace in the garage will need to be replaced this summer.
- Agenda meetings will resume virtually for the foreseeable future. Monthly meetings may be held outdoors when the weather permits.
- HR spoke with a code enforcement officer. His fee would be \$60/case. Will meet with Richardson's to give them the same opportunity.
